### FOR QUICK TURNAROUND OF APPLICATIONS AND RENEWALS PLEASE EMAIL AND SCAN DOCUMENTS WHERE POSSIBLE

It is the Club Member's responsibility to send renewals and applications in a timely manner.

#### New Permits (Morris Minor and non-Morris Minor Vehicles and Motorcycles)

You must be either a life member or financial (paid up) member before you can apply for a new permit.

An application fee of \$20 is required. Payment can be made via cash or cheque to the MMCCV Secretary or a Committee member at MMCCV monthly meetings. There is no 6-month membership qualification time for any Morris Minor vehicle for new members.

When applying for a permit for a:

#### Morris Minor

Email or mail a copy of the vehicles current RWC, proof of ownership and the following **(2) VicRoads forms** 1. Club Permit Application form 2. Vehicle Eligibility and Standards Declaration for Club Permit Scheme Vehicle form.

#### Non-Morris Minor Vehicles and Motorcycles

Applications must be accompanied by all the above plus proof of current registration of a Morris Minor vehicle held in the name of the applicant. Members wanting to register a non-Morris Minor or motorcycle must have been a member of our Club for at least 6 months.

#### All Morris Minor and Non-Morris Minor vehicle applications must include (6) recent photos:

**Motorcycle photos should include** 1,2 & 5 (above) plus LHS RHS views and speedo.

Mailed photos should be signed and dated on back. Electronic photos are authenticated by email date.

You **must** notify the CPS Officer (Geoff Shepherd) of your red plate permit number within 48 hours of VicRoads issue via email to [morrisminorclubplates@gmail.com](mailto:morrisminorclubplates@gmail.com) or phone 0419 137 711. Failure to notify the CPS Officer of your club permit number can have serious consequences for the Club and may cause the Club's permit scheme to be suspended by VicRoads for failure to keep up to date records.

#### Renewals

Remember to sign your renewal application. If your application is not signed it will be returned to you. No photos are required for renewal applications. Please email or, if mailing, send a stamped self-addressed envelope with VicRoads forms. No renewal reminders will be issued to permit holders. Please do not request the CPS Registrar mail your renewal and payment to VicRoads

#### Rules Regarding Club CPS Responsibilities

A vehicle is not eligible for a Club Permit if any of the following conditions exist:

**The member has ceased to be financial.**

**The vehicle is being used for commercial gain.**

**The vehicle is unroadworthy.**

**The vehicle is sold with logbook and plates.**

**The vehicle is sold to a friend so that a new logbook might be obtained.**

## GENERAL MEETING MINUTES OF THE MORRIS MINOR CAR CLUB OF VICTORIA INC.

HELD AT THE HORRIE WATSON HALL, DEEPDENE AND ALSO VIA ZOOM ON  
THURSDAY 13<sup>TH</sup> JUNE 2024

The President welcomed the members present and online and opened the meeting at 8.00pm.

**Committee Members Present:** President: Stewart Carr; Vice President: Russell Hatton;  
Secretary: Ed James; Treasurer: Katie Hamilton; CPS Officer: Geoff Shepherd; Membership:  
Jim Gourlay; Club Captain: Mark Bosley (online for part of meeting) and Webmaster: John Druery.

**Attendance:** Approximately 23 members were present and online.

**Apologies:** Alan Todd, Percy and Cheryl Scicluna, Barb Went and Geoff Nougher.

**Visitors and New Members:** Nil.

**Acceptance of Minutes:** Minutes of the previous meeting held 9<sup>th</sup> May 2024 accepted on the motion of Jim Gourlay and seconded by Trevor Sarbach.

**President's Report:** As per the Generator. Stewart gave an update on the ongoing repairs to Braidy's engine. Also he has unfortunately been notified that several members have passed away.

**Vice President's Report:** Russell gave a rundown of the successful run to Panton Hill via the Kangaroo Ground lookout and thanked Jim Gourlay for looking after the organising of the run. It was attended by 6 Morries and 3 moderns.

**Secretary's Report:** Ed advised that various items of information have been received by email and forwarded to appropriate office bearers. Some enquiries received about the sale of Morris Minors and/or parts together with technical requests. These have been referred to appropriate persons. A person in Langwarrin wants to give away a Morris Minor service folder if anyone is interested.

**Treasurer's Report:** Katie advised that we have a current operating balance of \$5,522.29. With our term deposit of \$9,148.84 we have a combined balance of our accounts of \$14,671.13. The term deposit earned \$415.46 interest which has increased its balance. Katie advised that the clubs accounts have now been audited with no issues raised.

**Membership Officer's Report:** As per the Generator we currently have 170 members including 7 Life members. We have one new member this month. Jim advised that we currently have 16 members who are unfinancial.

**Club Captain's Report:** Mark reported online and his report is as per the Generator. We have runs and events organised until the end of the year. The next event is on 23<sup>rd</sup> June being a movie afternoon at the Balwyn Theatre. Katie is doing the organising for the Christmas in July event at the St Anne's Winery and she needs to know numbers by 9<sup>th</sup> July. On say Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> August we are looking at going to the Fox Museum. We are still looking for ideas and suggestions for future runs.

**CPS Officer's Report:** Geoff advised that we now have 95 vehicles on our club permit scheme. He is sorting out another 4 vehicles going onto our scheme and advised that Richard McKellar is planning to bring his 12 vehicles across to our register. Geoff has had a problem with members sending him their registration paperwork 2 to 4 weeks after they are due and asked that all members send them to him well before the due date. Members need to do the right thing by the club as they receive their renewals at least 4 to 6 weeks before they are due and if they bring the renewals to a meeting 4 different people can actually sign the renewal form. Geoff advised that VicRoads is not accepting digital signatures. He also advised that members need to check the dates on their CPS window stickers as some of the dates have been found to be wrong.

**Editor's Report:** Nil as Barb absent.

**AOMC Report:** Stewart attended the recent AOMC meeting. There was a presentation at the meeting from the Garage Girls which is a theatre performance going around the state. The AOMC has 2 meetings a year with VicRoads regarding the Club Permit Scheme. If anyone has issues about this scheme that they want the AOMC to bring up with VicRoads, they can give them directly to the AOMC or pass them to Stewart to bring up with the AOMC. Also brought up at the meeting was that if your vehicle has a VASS certificate for a modification and you want to remove that modification to bring it back to a standard vehicle you have to get another VASS certificate for this. They have an upcoming Management Seminar on Risk and Finance for clubs for anyone

wishing to attend. Their next meeting is on 24<sup>th</sup> August in Shepparton.

### **GENERAL BUSINESS**

1. Nominations are open for all positions on the Committee for voting at the AGM. Some nominations have already been received. We are therefore looking for nominations for a Secretary, Webmaster and a Librarian;

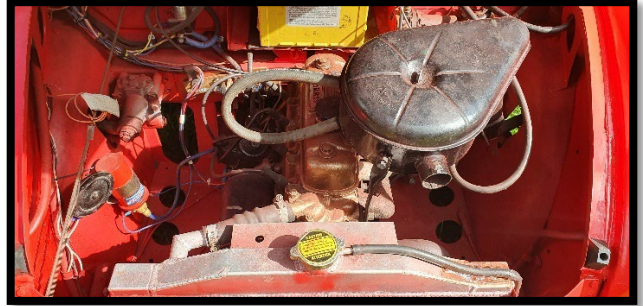

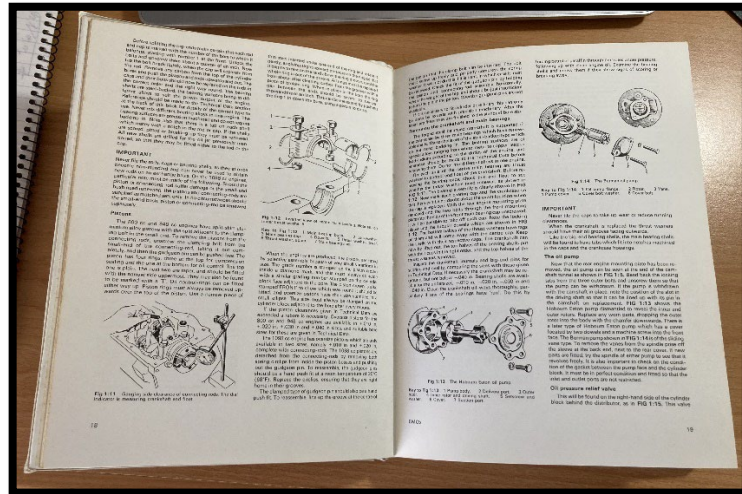
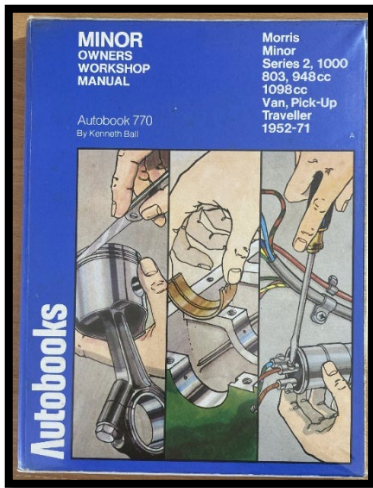
