FOR QUICK TURNAROUND OF APPLICATIONS AND RENEWALS

PLEASE EMAIL AND SCAN DOCUMENTS WHERE POSSIBLE

It is the Club Member's responsibility to send renewals and applications in a timely manner.

New Permits (Morris Minor and non-Morris Minor Vehicles)

You must be either a life member or financial (paid up) member for a period of 6 months + before you can apply for a new permit. An application fee of \$20 is required. Payment can be made via cash or cheque made out to the MMCCV to the MMCCV Secretary or a Committee member at MMCCV monthly meetings.

When applying for a permit for a:

Morris Minor: Email or mail a copy of the vehicles current RWC, proof of ownership and the following **(2) VicRoads forms** 1. Club Permit Application form. 2. Vehicle Eligibility and Standards Declaration for Club Permit Scheme Vehicle form.

Non-Morris Minor: Applications must be accompanied by all the above plus proof of current registration of a Morris Minor vehicle held in the name of the applicant.

All Morris Minor and Non-Morris Minor applications must include (6) recent photos showing images of: 1. Vehicle front. 2. Vehicle rear. 3. Vehicle driver's side. 4. Vehicle driving position (side on with driver's door open). 5. Chassis number or ID plate. 6. Vehicle engine bay. All mailed photos should be signed and dated on back. Electronic photos are authenticated by email date.

You **must** notify the CPS Officer (Geoff Shepherd) of your red plate permit number within 48 hours of VicRoads issue via email cpsregistrar@morrisminorvic.org.au and morrisminorclubplates@gmail.com or phone 0419 137 711. Failure to notify the CPS Officer of your club permit number can have serious consequences for the Club and may cause the Club's permit scheme to be suspended by VicRoads for failure to keep up to date records.

Renewals: Do not forget to sign your renewal application. If your application is not signed it will be returned to you. No photos are required for renewal applications.

Please email or, if mailing, send a stamped self-addressed envelope with VicRoads forms. It is your responsibility to renew on time. No renewal reminders will be issued to permit holders.

Rules Regarding Club CPS Responsibilities

A vehicle is not eligible for a Club Permit if any of the following conditions exist:

The member has ceased to be financial.


The vehicle is being used for commercial gain.

The vehicle is unroadworthy.

The vehicle is sold with logbook and plates.

The vehicle is sold to a friend so that a new logbook might be obtained.

Further information on the Club Permit Scheme (CPS) can be found on the VicRoads website.







Roadworthy eCertificate (eRWC) system

LVTs will be able to generate electronic copies for emailing to vehicle owners.


LVTs will provide a printed a copy for the vehicle owner upon request, or the vehicle owner can simply print it themselves from the email they receive.

The Certificate of Roadworthiness continues to include all the fields that are required to submit a registration, registration transfer or club permit application form.

VicRoads staff are also able to verify the Certificate of Roadworthiness details provided on the Certificates of Roadworthiness from the E RWC system.

Roadworthy e Certificate (eRWC) system is already being used by a number of Victorian Licensed Vehicle Testers (LVT) to create, manage and store their certificates of roadworthiness online.

So if your club requires a hard copy certificate for recording then the applicant needs to request a copy from Vic Roads. Apparently if they provide an E address then a copy is sent to them.

GENERAL MEETING MINUTES OF THE MORRIS MINOR CAR CLUB OF VICTORIA INC.

HELD AT THE HORRIE WATSON HALL, DEEPDENE AND ALSO VIA ZOOM ON THURSDAY 14TH JULY 2022

The President welcomed the members present and online and opened the meeting at 8.06pm.

Committee Members Present: President: Stewart Carr; Treasurer: Katie Hamilton; Editor: Barb Went; Secretary: Ed James; Membership: Jim Gourlay; and CPS Officer: Geoff Shepherd.

Attendance: Approximately 18 members were present together with 3 members via Zoom.

Apologies: Alan & Liam Todd, Catriona Bruce, Percy & Cheryl Scicluna, Henry Edwards, Geoff Nougher, John & Ann Druery, Ian Kulne and Anne Carr.

Visitors and New Members: New member Rob Spillman was present. He has a sky blue 2 door Morris Minor 1000 which came from Western Australia.

Acceptance of Minutes

Minutes of the previous meeting held 9th June 2022 accepted on the motion of Jim Gourlay and seconded by Geoff Shepherd.

President's Report: As per the Generator.

Secretary's Report: Various items of information have been received by email and forwarded to appropriate office bearers. A Thank You card was received from Henry Edwards for the support the club had given Henry and his family on the recent passing of Marlene. The AOMC provided information on VicRoads Roadworthy eCertificate process. Some enquiries received about the sale of Morris Minors and/or parts together with technical requests. These have been referred to appropriate persons.

Treasurer's Report: Katie advised that we have a current operating balance of \$6,790.28. With our term deposit of \$8,512.07 we have a combined balance of our accounts of \$15,302.35. Our term deposit had earned \$14.81 interest and was renewed for 12 months at an interest rate of 2.6%.

Membership Officer's Report: As per the Generator. Jim advised that we currently have 177 members including 7 Life members. We have 2 new members who came on our last run and 2 other new members.

Club Captain's Report: While we no longer have a Club Captain, Jim advised that our next run is the Mid-Year luncheon being held at Tabcorp Park in Melton on 17th July. Wayne has to be notified who is attending by tonight. Braidy is organising next month's run which she advised is to Mount Macedon on 14th August. We will meet at the McDonalds on the corner of Camp Road & Sydney Road before proceeding to the destination. Mark Parritt is organising the run to the McClelland Gallery on 25th September, the Morrykana is to be held in October at Roxburgh College, and the November run on Melbourne Cup Day will either be to Henry Edwards place in Whittlesea or the nearby Yan Yean Reservoir. We will again do the Australia Day Run to Westerfolds Park. The Christmas Party is to be held at the Manningham Club (opposite the Veneto Club) on 1st December.

CPS Officer's Report: Geoff advised that as per the Generator we presently have 101 cars on club plates. Geoff has already processed about 10% of the club's renewals of which 9 were done online and 3 by mail. Renewals can be signed by Geoff, Neil, Stewart or Ed. It is a VicRoads requirement that we maintain photographs of vehicles submitted with new CPS applications to prove that they have not been modified at a later date. Geoff advised that he was recently pulled up by the Police doing a thorough check of all red plated vehicles and logbooks.

Editor's Report: Barb present but nothing to report.

- 3. Jim advised that our CB radios have a very short range and that we need to replace them with better radios. It was asked if any members within the club had some knowledge of CB radios so that they could assist in purchasing the replacement ones. A member advised that we would be better off not getting CB radios with rechargeable batteries because of problems they had with them in the past;
- 4. Neil Cheney thanked us for the card he received from the club on the recent passing of his mother.

Jim Gourlay noticed that his car was not performing very well on the last run. He checked his spark plugs and noticed a build up on them. He brought in the his spark plugs which he had replaced and asked for some advice regarding the cause of the build up on them.





We learnt that the car was running rich and that the cause could be related to fuel or oil.

If the build up is caused by oil you will get a wet, black, oily, carbon deposits but if it is dry, soft and fluffy then it is likely related to fuel.


