It is the Club Member's responsibility to send renewals and applications in a timely manner.

New Permits (Morris Minor and non-Morris Minor Vehicles and Motorcycles)

You must be either a life member or financial (paid up) member before you can apply for a new permit. An application fee of \$20 is required. Payment can be made via cash or cheque to the MMCCV Secretary or a Committee member at MMCCV monthly meetings. There is no 6-month membership qualification time for any Morris Minor vehicle for new members.

When applying for a permit for a:

Morris Minor

Email or mail a copy of the vehicles current RWC, proof of ownership and the following **(2) VicRoads forms** 1. Club Permit Application form 2. Vehicle Eligibility and Standards Declaration for Club Permit Scheme Vehicle form.

Non-Morris Minor Vehicles and Motorcycles

Applications must be accompanied by all the above plus proof of current registration of a Morris Minor vehicle held in the name of the applicant. Members wanting to register a non-Morris Minor or motorcycle must have been a member of our Club for at least 6 months.

All Morris Minor and Non-Morris Minor vehicle applications must include (6) recent photos:

1. Vehicle front

2. Vehicle rear

3. Vehicle driver's side

4. Vehicle driving position (side on, driver's door open)

5. Chassis no or ID plate

6. Vehicle engine bay

Motorcycle photos should include 1,2 & 5 (above) plus LHS RHS views and speedo.

Mailed photos should be signed and dated on back. Electronic photos are authenticated by email date.

You **must** notify the CPS Officer (Geoff Shepherd) of your red plate permit number within 48 hours of VicRoads issue via email to morrisminorclubplates@gmail.com or phone 0419 137 711. Failure to notify the CPS Officer of your club permit number can have serious consequences for the Club and may cause the Club's permit scheme to be suspended by VicRoads for failure to keep up to date records.

Renewals

Remember to sign your renewal application. If your application is not signed it will be returned to you. No photos are required for renewal applications. Please email or, if mailing, send a stamped self-addressed envelope with VicRoads forms. No renewal reminders will be issued to permit holders. Please do not request the CPS Registrar mail your renewal and payment to VicRoads

Rules Regarding Club CPS Responsibilities

A vehicle is not eligible for a Club Permit if any of the following conditions exist:

The member has ceased to be financial.

The vehicle is being used for commercial gain.

The vehicle is unroadworthy.

The vehicle is sold with logbook and plates.

The vehicle is sold to a friend so that a new logbook might be obtained.



The President welcomed the members present and online and opened the meeting at 8.01pm.

Committee Members Present: President: Stewart Carr; Treasurer: Katie Hamilton.

Editor: Barb Went; Secretary: Ed James; and Membership: Jim Gourlay.

Attendance: Approximately 23 members were present together with 4 members via Zoom.

Apologies: Geoff Shepherd, Alan Todd, Cheryl Scicluna, Henry Edwards, Mike Dobson, Catriona Bruce, and Ross & Anne Carr.

Visitors and New Members: Graham Waldron who has a 1949 low light which has recently been damaged in an accident.

Acceptance of Minutes

Minutes of the previous meeting held 13th October 2022 accepted on the motion of Stewart Carr and seconded by Jim Gourlay.

President's Report: As per the Generator. Stewart referred to Rob Smith and they discussed problems Rob had while removing the motor from his vehicle a spring washer fell into one of the cylinders.

Secretary's Report: Various items of information have been received by email and forwarded to appropriate office bearers. Notice received reminding us that the Geelong Revival is on the 25th to 27th November and that the Rob Roy Revival is to be held on 18- 19 March 2023. Some enquiries received about the sale of Morris Minors and/or parts together with technical requests. These have been referred to appropriate persons.

Treasurer's Report: Katie advised that we have a current operating balance of \$4,968.71. With our term deposit of \$8,512.07 we have a combined balance of our accounts of \$13,480.78. Katie also advised that so far 26 people have paid up for the Christmas Party.

Membership Officer's Report: As per the Generator. Jim advised that we currently have 184 members including 7 Life members. An additional membership application was received in tonight's mail.

Club Captain's Report: While we no longer have a Club Captain, various members spoke about upcoming events. The November run to Yan Yean Reservoir was cancelled due to bad weather. The Christmas party is at the Manningham Club on Thursday 1st December. Commencement time will be 6.00pm for a 6.30pm dinner. It has been decided for this event that the club would also subsidize a second option for dessert giving a choice of either a pavlova or plum pudding at an extra cost of \$4 per person. Payment for each attendee remains at \$30. Katie is to be advised of any dietary requirements. Our usual Australia Day Run to Westerfolds Park is to be held again. A run is being organized for 12th February and another run is being arranged to a Lavender Farm in March. We are looking for people to organize other runs next year. Braidy is organizing the club's involvement in the Florence Thompson run which will be held in the Wangaratta — Beechworth area at the end of April next year. 
