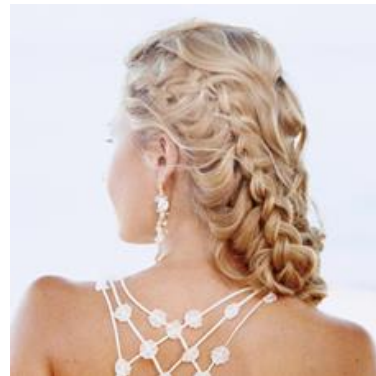

The President welcomed the members present and opened the meeting at 8.05pm.

Apologies: Graham & Lesley Dines (Standing Apology), Jim Gourlay, Ken Urquhart, Gillian Asquith.

Attendance: Approx 30 members were present at the meeting as recorded in the attendance book

Visitors and New Members; visitor John Russell (guest speaker) was welcomed by those present

Minutes of the previous Meeting accepted on the motion of Tim Lengyel seconded by Rosalee Harper

President's Report as per the Generator

Vice President's Report Nil but referred to great time had by those who attended the excellent Melb Cup Day event at Ballarat hosted by Wayne and Lyn which was also acknowledged by Mark
(a big thank-you to Wayne and Lyn for their warm hospitality on the day)

Secretary's Report The Secretary advised the meeting of the following items which he indicated he would display after the meeting for the members perusal.: (a) newsletters from AOMC, MMCC Sth Aust, and the National Motor Racing Museum and (b) advertising material for Watsonia Motor Show 21 Nov, Lara Lions Club Classic Car Show 22 Nov, Garfield Rotary Club Car Show 29 Nov, Akoonah Park Men's Shed Summer Classic Car & Bike Show 5 Dec, 2 Jan, 13 Feb, 12 Mar, Gisborne Rotary Club presenting Shannon's Classic Motorcycle & Car Auction 6 Dec, RACV Great Australian Rally for Peter Mac "Melbourne to Mornington" 17 Jan, Bairnsdale Car Club "Motor Expo" on 14 Feb, Vintage Drivers Club Yarra Glen Swap Meet & Classic Car Display 21 Feb and BMC- Leyland Car Club "Show N Shine" at Caribbean Gardens 20 Mar, 2016.

Treasurer's Report: Neil reported a current balance of \$4264. He also indicated that he is now accepting Club Christmas Party dues (\$30 pp after Club subsidy) and encouraged members to finalise their payments asap. At the time of the meeting only 38 bookings had been made for the Christmas Party which many considered a poor result given the total Club membership.

Membership Officer Barbara reported that currently there were 168 financial members (45 postal 123 e-mail) and 81 red plated vehicles listed in the Club. Mark indicated that the total number of members would be closer to over 300 persons as most memberships would include a partner. Ross advised meeting of a sick member at Benalla (Robert Mackie). Barbara said she would send him a card from the Club.

Club Captain: Stewart gave a brief run-down of recent Club events and mentioned future events as listed in the Generator including a Charity Challenge involving other clubs for Bowel Cancer Research around May/June next year.

Regalia Graham H reported all going well and plenty of regalia available for sale including new bucket hats @ \$15 each with or without his autograph.

Editors Report; Mark reported that Graham D is now back from overseas and all going well

A O M C- Stewart mentioned that the AOMC Survey re 25/30 year proposal for CPS vehicles currently under review by VicRoads indicated that the majority of clubs favoured 25 years

National Rally Richard McKellar indicated that the 2017 National Rally was still in the planning stage and that most of the Clubs who had expressed views on the format of the rally wanted a 2 day event. He indicated that at this early stage the event may possibly comprise of an unofficial 1st day at Harcourt with BBQ followed by DOMM type event on the Sunday with a people's choice of judging but with optional concourse component for which entrants would pay a premium entry fee.

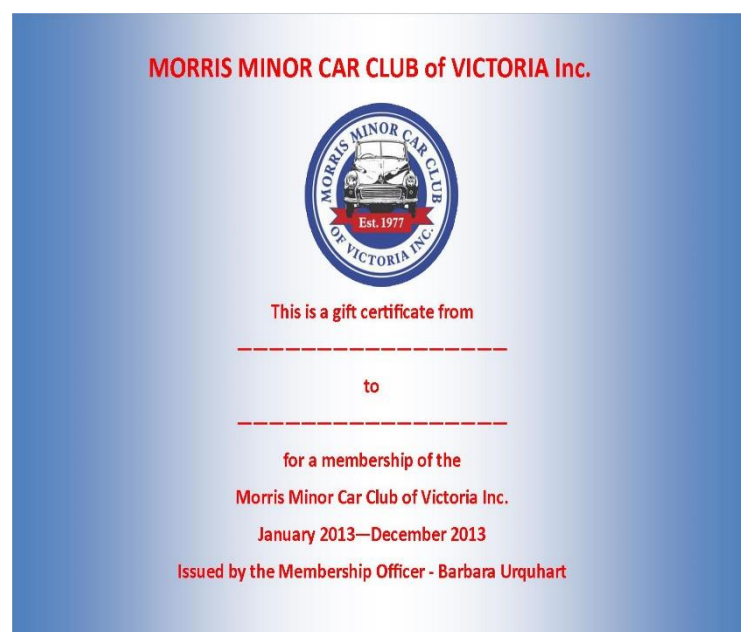
