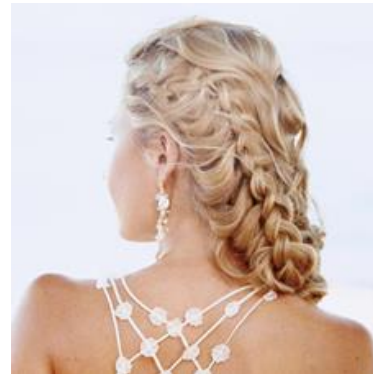

I have been a Series 2 Minor owner since 1969, it was my first car. Although the original body shell has gone, I still have all the parts. In the early 1980's I purchased a complete, running and registered original 1955 4 door series 2 minor that was identical to mine, except that it was light green instead of regal blue. The acquired car was in excellent, rust free condition. The panels were removed to start the restoration project, but it remains a rolling chassis with original engine and gearbox installed and should be operational with proper re-commissioning. The car has always been garaged and is now stored in a dry container on my property at Carlsruhe, Victoria where I reside.

The jewel in the crown is that I have a 1098cc sprite motor that I installed in my original car. It is the 10CCDAH engine with the stronger crankshaft. It is dismantled but should be complete if I can collate all the parts from my shelves. I understand from Bugeye Barn that these engines are now rare.

I have recently purchased a 1929 Morris Minor "Special" that will take all my restoration attention.

Therefore I wish to sell my Series 2 Minor "Project" to someone who is willing to complete it.

The catch is that the purchaser must take "ALL" my Series 2 parts and panels collection and be willing to accept any bits I bring to them, for free, if I subsequently find them in the workshop clean up. This would only occur if the purchaser was interested in the subsequently discovered bits. I imagine there would be at least two tandem trailer loads in the collection, one for the car and at least another for the additional parts and panels.

I am looking for offers at, or above \$2000.00 from a Morris person. If there is no interest, I will list it at a higher price on eBay, but I would prefer not to sell it on the open market.

As I am old, I have no tolerance of stupid people, so if you have any members who have the attention span to read this lengthy email, then we are off to a good start.

President's Report: as per the Generator

Vice President's Report: nil

Secretary's Report: Michael read out Christmas Card from the Cornwall MM Club which he will be acknowledging on behalf of Club (Mark to try to visit that Club on this year's trip to UK) and a letter from Chester McKaige referring to his early involvement in the Club's formation and enclosing a much appreciated and generous donation towards the 40th lunch.

Suggested items for the raffle are:- wine, chocolates/sweets, car products etc.

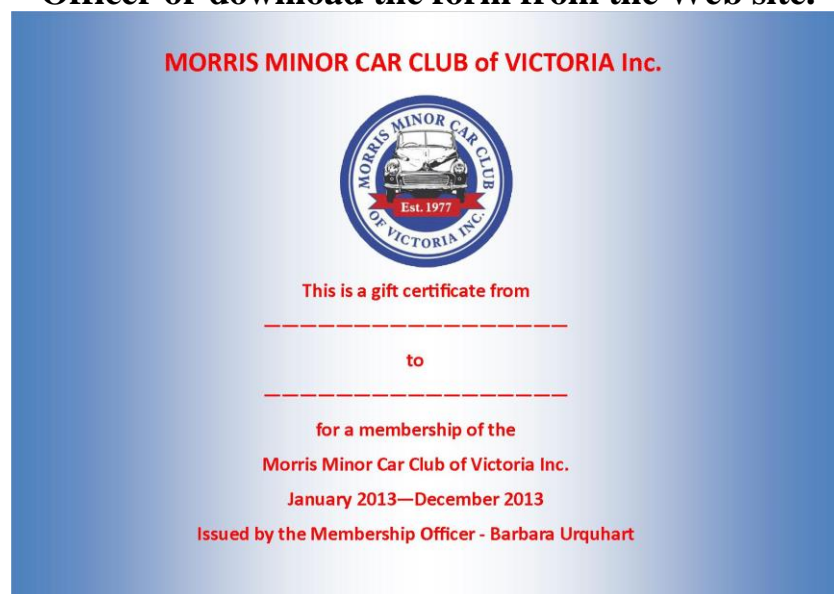

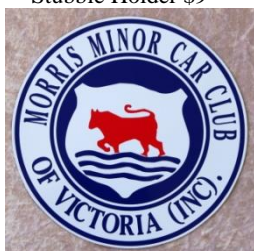
