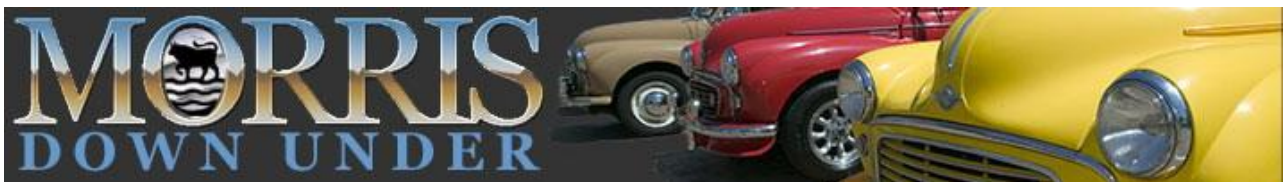

In 1994 Richard & Bill McKellar imported a limited edition 1960 Morris Minor Million to restore but the restoration did not start in earnest until 2008. Only 350 of the cars with its trademark lilac duco and white upholstery, were produced. This was the first one to reach Australia, Richard said.

The badly rusted car better described as “a bomb”, was taken up to his father’s garage in North Harcourt, in Victoria's north, to await its restoration.

It took them from 2008 until this year. McKellar, a father of two with a supportive wife, spent every available weekend in North Harcourt.

“We stripped the car back to nothing, took off all the paint. Any rust was cut out and any new parts were welded in,” he said.

It was his mother Claire, whose painting studio he commandeered for repainting the car’s panels, who suggested he keep a diary. What emerged was a story of a father and son bonding as they worked together on the car’s transformation.

“There are times when you might disagree about things but you work through those disagreements,” he said. “But it is lovely to share a passion with someone.”
