It is the Club Member's responsibility to send renewals and applications in a timely manner.

New Permits (Morris Minor and non-Morris Minor Vehicles and Motorcycles)

You must be either a life member or financial (paid up) member before you can apply for a new permit.

An application fee of \$20 is required. Payment can be made via cash or cheque to the MMCCV Secretary or a Committee member at MMCCV monthly meetings. There is no 6-month membership qualification time for any Morris Minor vehicle for new members.

When applying for a permit for a:

Morris Minor

Email or mail a copy of the vehicle's current RWC, proof of ownership and the following (2) VicRoads forms: 1. Club Permit Application form 2. Vehicle Eligibility and Standards Declaration for Club Permit Scheme Vehicle form.

Non-Morris Minor Vehicles and Motorcycles

Applications must be accompanied by all the above plus proof of current registration of a Morris Minor vehicle held in the name of the applicant. Members wanting to register a non-Morris Minor or motorcycle must have been a member of our Club for at least 6 months.

All Morris Minor and Non-Morris Minor vehicle applications must include (6) recent photos:

Motorcycle photos should include 1, 2 & 5 (above) plus LHS-RHS views and speedo.

Mailed photos should be signed and dated on back. Electronic photos are authenticated by email date.

You must notify the CPS Officer (Geoff Shepherd) of your red plate permit number within 48 hours of VicRoads issue via email to morrisminorclubplates@gmail.com or phone 0419 137 711. Failure to notify the CPS Officer of your club permit number can have serious consequences for the Club and may cause the Club's permit scheme to be suspended by VicRoads for failure to keep up to date records.

Renewals

Remember to sign your renewal application. If your application is not signed it will be returned to you. No photos are required for renewal applications. Please email or, if mailing, send a stamped self-addressed envelope with VicRoads forms. No renewal reminders will be issued to permit holders. Please do not request the CPS Registrar mail your renewal and payment to VicRoads.

Rules Regarding Club CPS Responsibilities

A vehicle is not eligible for a Club Permit if any of the following conditions exist:

The member has ceased to be financial.

The vehicle is being used for commercial gain.

The vehicle is unroadworthy.

The vehicle is sold with logbook and plates.

The vehicle is sold to a friend so that a new logbook might be obtained.

GENERAL MEETING MINUTES OF THE MORRIS MINOR CAR CLUB OF VICTORIA INC.

HELD AT THE HORRIE WATSON HALL, DEEPPENE AND ALSO VIA ZOOM ON

THURSDAY 13 TH OCTOBER 2022

The President welcomed the members present and online and opened the meeting at 8.01pm.

Committee Members Present: President: Stewart Carr; Treasurer: Katie Hamilton;
Editor: Barb Went; Secretary: Ed James; Membership: Jim Gourlay; and Regalia: Alan Todd.

Attendance: Approximately 10 members were present together with 8 members via Zoom.

Apologies: Geoff Shepherd, Percy & Cheryl Scicluna, Henry Edwards, Mike Dobson, Barry & Marjie Phillips, Joe Foster and Ron Roney.

Visitors and New Members: None.

Acceptance of Minutes

Minutes of the previous meeting held 8th September 2022 accepted on the motion of Ross Carr and seconded by Katie Hamilton.

President's Report: As per the Generator. Stewart thanked Mark Parritt for the excellent work he did in organising the very successful run to the McClelland Gallery.

Secretary's Report: Various items of information have been received by email and forwarded to appropriate office bearers. Notice received reminding us that the Geelong Revival is on the 25th to 27th November. We regularly receive from a company called 'The Vintage and Classic Car Hub/Star Cars Agency' that want cars for movie sets and asked if any members are interested in being paid for their vehicles participating in such events. Stewart said that if you have Red Plates, you could not do this work and you would have to make sure your insurance covers this as well. Some enquiries received about the sale of Morris Minors and/or parts together with technical requests. These have been referred to appropriate persons.

Treasurer's Report: Katie advised that we have a current operating balance of \$6,051.96. With our term deposit of \$8,512.07 we have a combined balance of our accounts of \$14,564.03. Katie also advised that our insurance premium is due this month.

Membership Officer's Report: As per the Generator. Jim advised that we currently have 184 members including 7 Life members. We have no new members this month.

Club Captain's Report: While we no longer have a Club Captain, various members spoke about upcoming events. The Morrykana is to be held this Sunday at Roxburgh College, and we are participating in the Geelong club's memorial run to Daylesford on Sunday 23rd October. The November run is to Yan Yean Reservoir which Eric has volunteered to set up. Christmas is at the Manningham Club on Thursday 1st December. Commencement time will be 6.00pm for a 6.30pm dinner. It has been decided for this event given that the 2 course meals will cost \$38 for each person, the club will subsidise them by \$8 making the cost for each attendee \$30. Payments are to be made to the club's account. An email notice will be sent out about this shortly. Our usual Australia Day Run to Westerfolds Park is to be held again. We are looking for people to organise other runs next year.

CPS Officer's Report: Geoff absent but had advised that we presently have 102 cars on club plates. He has so far processed 30 registration renewals since he took over at the beginning of May.

Regalia Officers: Alan advised that he is proceeding well with the shirt designs for the National Rally. He is also close to finalising the bucket hat design to be made in different colours and they should be ready for summer. He hopes to bring some samples along to the next meeting.

Editor's Report: Barb advised that the club's calendar for next year is close to being ready and hopefully will be available at the next meeting.

AOMC: Nothing more to report at present other than their American Motoring Show later in the month. Braidy advised that the AOMC are planning a campaign to get young drivers to learn to drive manual cars and thought our club should get behind this. The next AOMC meeting in November will be held in Springvale.

GENERAL BUSINESS

1. The closing dates are soon for entries for the National Rally. Our club members have been booking accommodation around the Glenelg area. Those attending the rally will be having a meeting sometime to discuss more specific details of the trip and preparing for the trip;
2. We still have vacancies on the Committee for a Vice President, Club Captain, Historian and Librarian for anyone wanting to take on a role.

Items for Sale, Wants & Needs:

Stewart has a good supply of poly nylon suspension bushes for sale.

Tips & Hints:

Stewart stressed the importance of checking your dashpot oil in the carburetor and in using the correct oil. Alan advised that he uses Penrite oil made specifically for vintage vehicles. To buy Penrite oil he goes to Murray Engineering at 39 Hutton Road, Dandenong. You can look up the Penrite website for details of the various oils, lubricants, coolants, fluids, etc. to use in your older vehicle. Stewart said that modern oils do not work well in old cars as they are too slippery. The Penrite Extra 10 oil (20W60) stays thicker when it is hot. He is to look at having an oil night at one of our meetings next year.

Stewart advised that for the National Rally, vehicles attending should have a major service with all oils changed and everything else checked.

There being no further business the meeting closed at 8.39pm followed by the drawing of the raffle.

Our stomachs were getting hungry, so we headed inside for a fantastic spread put on by Roxburgh College.

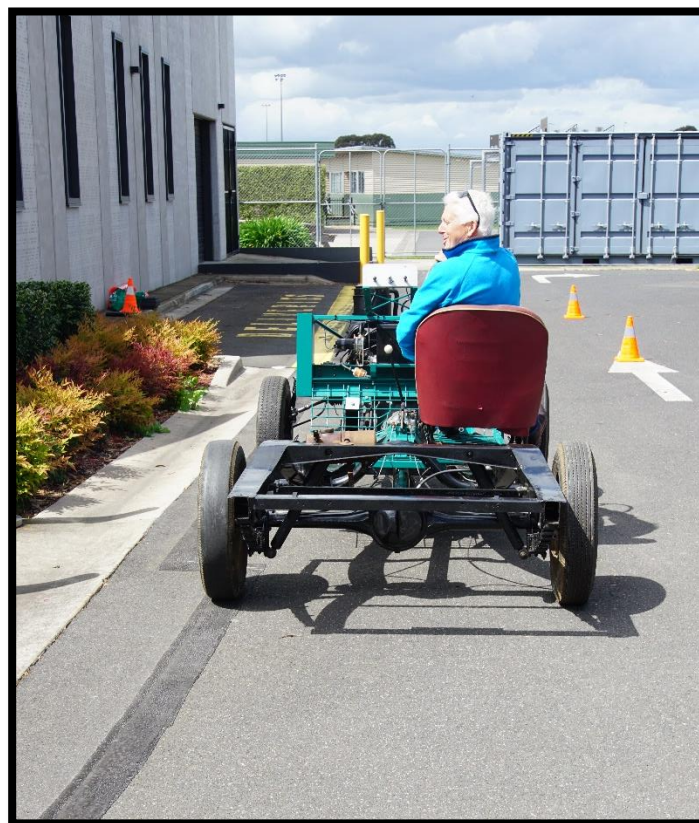
After lunch we had a tour of the College's technical department and saw some of the new machines they have got.

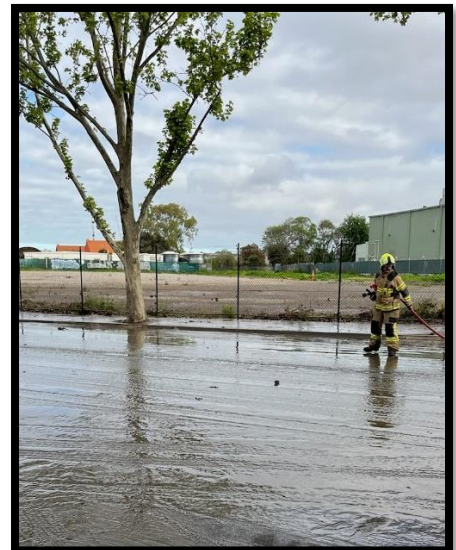

So, it was hurled into the middle of a closed off road, covered in mud from the previous day's flood.

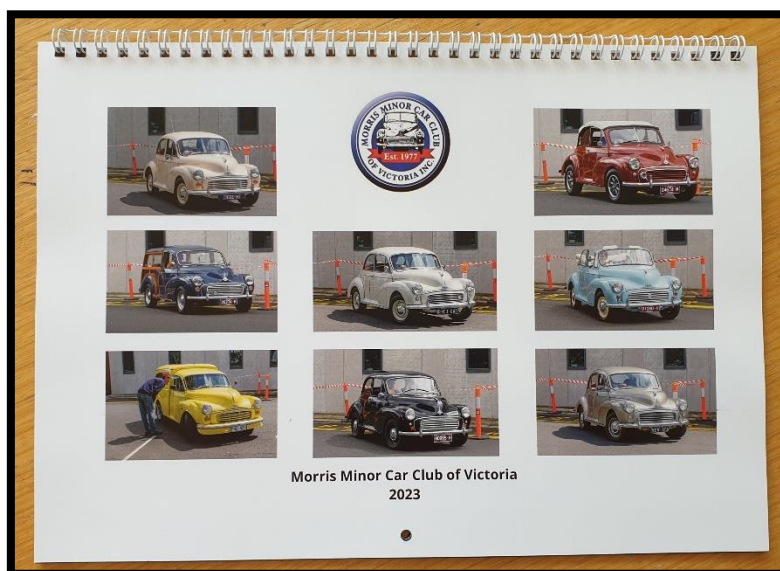
Just at that moment the fire brigade turned up to a false fire alarm in the building next door, and while perplexed at a fire ball being thrown 50m in front of them quickly put it out.
