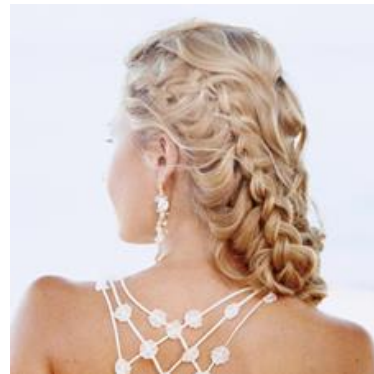

## **RUN REPORTS**

### **Yan Yean Run Report Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> October, 2015**

On sunny Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> October, seventeen happy souls gathered at McDonalds in Diamond Creek, in readiness for the run to the Yan Yean Reservoir, via the Black Saturday Bushfire Memorial at Strathewan, which the Club had previously visited about 2 years ago. These happy souls comprised Henry & Marlene Edwards who organised the run, Percy & Cheryl Scicluna, Michael & Veronica Dobson, Rosie & Graham Harper, Margaret & Malcolm Baker, Mark Parritt, Marcus Ball & David, Jim Gourlay, Stewart Carr, Tim Lengyel and Stephen Dynes, who was driving neither a Morrie or a modern, but a most beautiful MG TD sports car, the envy of all. After the compulsory coffee, and for us older members another toilet opportunity, we set off around 10.45am and were soon on our way through some beautiful countryside via Wattle Glen, Kangaroo Ground, Panton Hill, Hurstbridge, and Cottles Bridge to Strathewan. Here the Group took in the significance of the memorial including the steel gum tree which had been fabricated from steel branches and leaves produced by blacksmiths from around the world following those terrible fires.

At around 12.15 pm we set off for the Yan Yean Reservoir, under 30 mins away, via Arthur's Creek. Upon arrival, after negotiating several horrendous speed humps, we were met by; Trish & Rob Smith, in their powder blue Morrie, Henry and Marlene's daughter Michelle (who had arrived earlier to hold a spot for us) and Tim Lengyel. 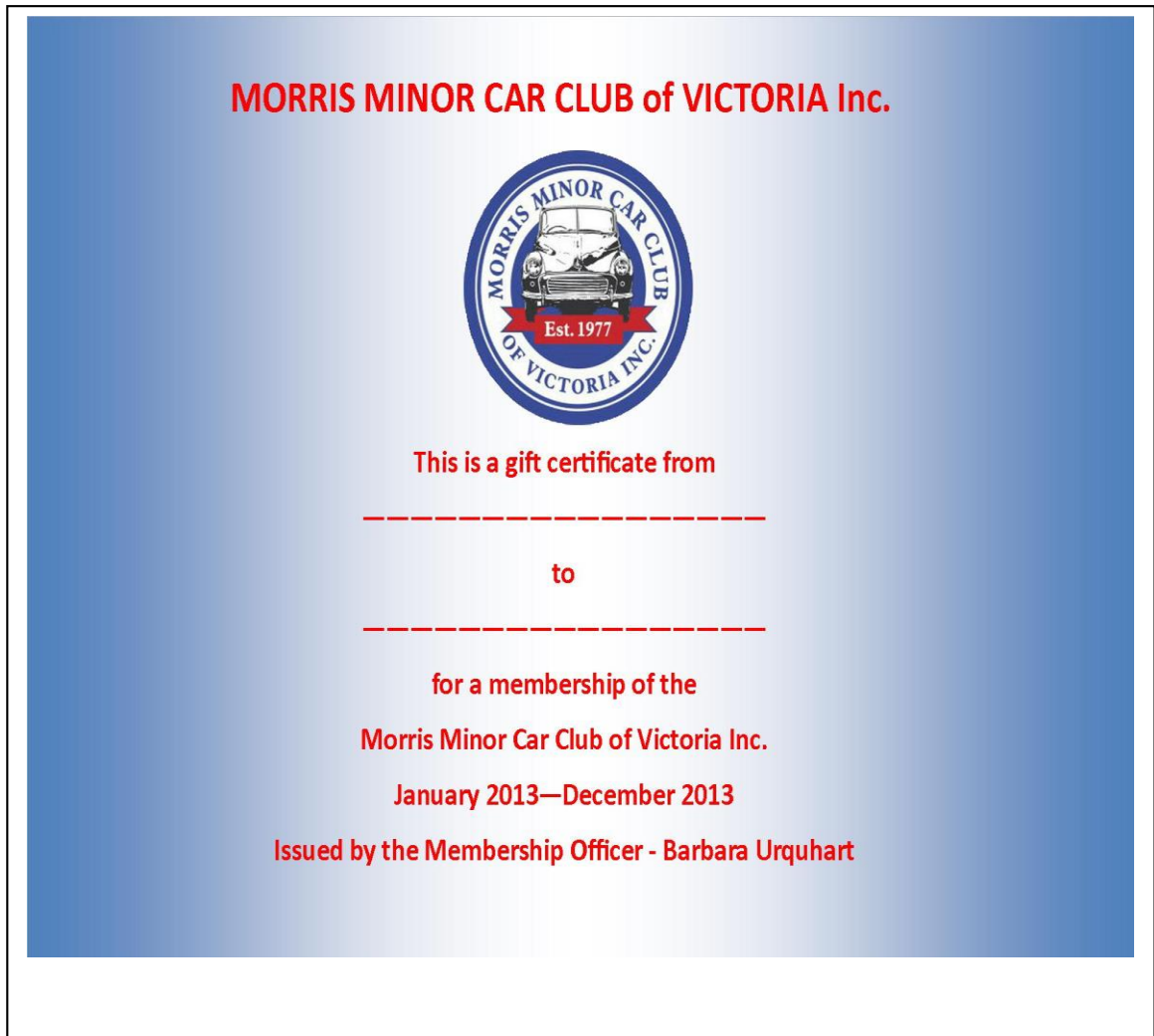

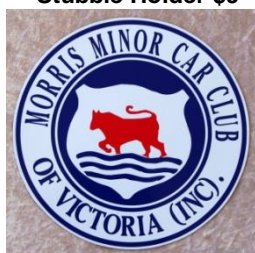
